

MI-TFPT-X MI TIMED FLOW PILLAR TAP



INSTALLATION

Installation must be carried out in accordance with the AS3500 Series, the NCC Volume 3 and any other local authority requirements.

Flush all supply lines thoroughly ensuring to remove all dirt and foreign matter. Install tap into basin or hob, tightening the fixing nut with either a shifter or multi-grips.

Ensure the tap is firmly attached to the basin or hob surface.

Connect the 15mm BSP inlet to water supply line.

After a successful connection, remove tap aerator and flush the tap, once flushed replace aerator.

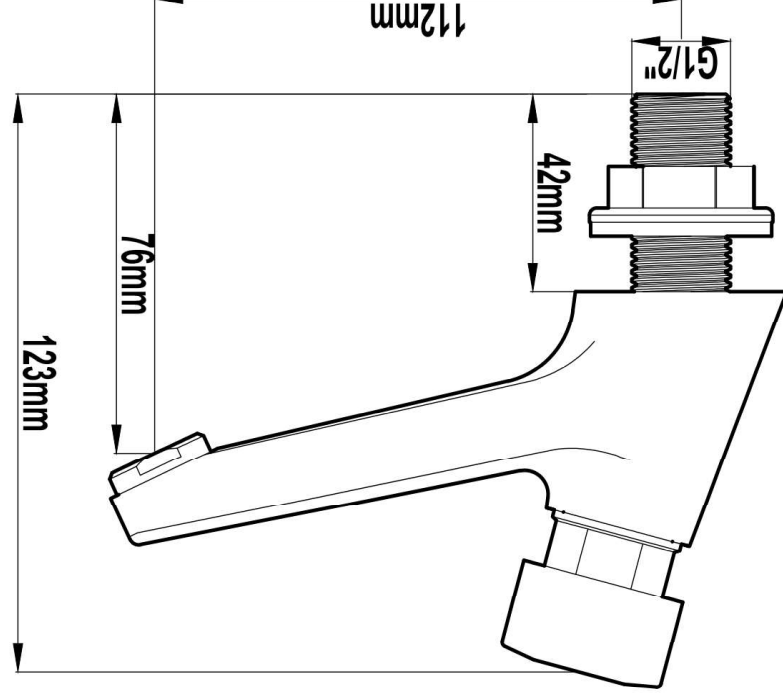
50-350kPa water inlet pressure – If inlet water pressure exceeds 350kPa a pressure limiting/reducing valve must be fitted.
